

Delivery Route Planner

Introduction

Welcome to RouteMaster Pro, the Delivery Route Planner. This intelligent, browser-based sat-nav and route planning tool is designed specifically for delivery operations. By calculating the fastest paths and most efficient stop orders using live mapping data, it helps cut mileage, reduce fuel spend by up to 30%, and keeps your drivers on track with turn-by-turn guidance.

1. Getting Started

Planning a Route

On the main screen, you will see the primary input panel for defining your journey alongside an interactive map. The system requires a starting point and a final destination to calculate a basic route.

Input Field	Description
Point A (Start)	Enter the starting address or postcode for the journey.
Point B (Destination)	Enter the final destination address or postcode.
Add Via Point	Click this button to add intermediate stops to the journey. You can add multiple via points to construct a complex, multi-stop delivery run.

Managing Custom Locations

To speed up daily route planning, the system allows you to save frequently visited addresses. Click the **Manage Locations** button at the top right to open the location manager.

Action	Description
Add New Location	Enter a memorable name (e.g., 'Home', 'Warehouse A', 'Singleton Hospital') and the full address or city, then click Save.
Saved Locations	View, edit, or delete your existing saved addresses. Keeping this list updated significantly reduces the time spent typing addresses during daily planning.

2. Navigation and Output

Once your route parameters are set, the system processes the data to generate the optimal path and guidance instructions.

Feature	Description
Using Saved Locations	Instead of typing full addresses into the Point A, Point B, or Via Point fields, you can click into any location field and select directly from your saved locations list.
Starting Navigation	Once all points are entered, click Start Navigation . The system will calculate the optimal route, display it visually on the interactive map on the right, and generate step-by-step Turn-by-Turn Guidance in the panel on the left.
Printing the Route	For drivers who require physical copies, or as a backup system, click Print Route . This action formats the map and the turn-by-turn directions into a clean, printer-friendly layout suitable for sharing.
